### Interesting Accessions

6230 Queen Street School, Abertillery. The records include a record book of pupil teachers, from the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, showing this method of training teachers; older pupils could be apprenticed and receive training from the head teacher while teaching selected classes. By this date, this system was coming to an end but was used as a stepping stone before candidates went on to obtain further qualifications at teacher training colleges. The training included the preparation of lessons, and observations on these are included in the Record Book.

6236 Newport Rugby Football Club. A large collection of records which were discovered in an attic at the club's premises in Rodney Parade, Newport. The records include photographs, programmes of sporting events, financial records, and papers relating to the club's members during the First World War. The records also relate to the other sporting bodies located at the same grounds in Newport.

6245 Records of Harry Poloway of Newport, Toastmaster, who died in 2016, aged 100. He was employed by Newport City Council as an electrical engineer but also had a long career as an MC and Toastmaster, working for Newport and then for Cardiff City Council. He officiated at many events including visits by royal and political figures, as well as sporting, business and charity occasions. The records include programmes of some of the events, photographs, and some personal records relating to his war service in the RAF and his activities as a boxing compère.
