The Gwent Archives Joint Committee is looking for a small number of motivated and enthusiastic individuals to join the Committee and help support the work of Gwent Archives.

If you have an interest in history and heritage and are familiar with the work of Gwent Archives or archives services generally we would love to hear from you. In particular we are interested in recruiting those with experience or knowledge in one or more of the following areas:

- The work of archive services, for example as a visitor, a depositor or volunteer
- The education sector at any level, including primary, secondary, further and higher education
- Securing grant funding from a range of funding bodies
- Working with community and/or heritage organisations

Meetings take place quarterly and are held in the daytime via Microsoft Teams and whilst co-opted members do not have voting rights, you will contribute ideas and suggestions from your own knowledge and experience to help inform decision making.

This is a voluntary role, but travel expenses will be reimbursed for attendance at any in person meetings. An introduction to Gwent Archives and to the work of the Joint Committee will be provided, as well as training on using Microsoft Teams if required.
